The Run for the Word 5K course will start on Zion Street, across Hwy. 153 from Trinity Lutheran Church. Turn right on Hoke Street, right again on Kimmons Street, and another right on Rice Street. Continue to Hwy. 29 Business, and turn left. Follow for 1.1 miles to the turnaround in the parking lot at Hogan's Cabinetry. Retrace the route back to Landis for 1 mile and turn right on Ridge Avenue and then left on Zion Street to finish beside Trinity Lutheran, the host facility.
